Up to \$5,000 - Boat Dock Refurbishing, Hood Park Porch Swing

\$5,000 to \$10,000 - Path around Three Meadows Pond

Over \$10,000 - Sunshades at Municipal or Rotary Park

REVIEW ACTION ITEMS FROM MEETING

Chair

Ms. Hagen discussed the \$5,000 allotted to PRAC on a yearly basis. She said that this money has to be used to purchase a physical object. She spoke about the installation of an Event Calendar at the Summer Rec Building, the addition of daffodils and sunflowers at the parks. She spoke about doing something about the muddy areas around the Disk Golf Field by possibly adding stone or mulch in these areas. The PRAC members also discussed using their budget for the installation of a Mini Skate Pad at one of the parks (location is still being debated). Ms. Hagen told the members to keep thinking of ideas to use the PRAC money or ideas for the Grant application in October.

OTHER BUSINESS

Ms. Hagen spoke about the placing of a memorial stone marking at Hood park for Native American remains that were discovered in 1996.
