

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING

PERRYSBURG CITY COUNCIL

AUGUST 16, 2022

Mayor Mackin called the first public hearing to order at 6:16 p.m. Present were Council members Mark Weber, Kevin Fuller, Cory Kuhlman, Barry VanHoozen, Jonathan Smith, and Tim McCarthy (6). Council member Jan Materni was not present. Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, Kate Sandretto, Law Director, Amber Rathburn, Clerk of Council, and Brody Walters, Planning and Zoning Administrator.

The purpose of the hearing was to hear public comment regarding an Assignment of Permanent Zoning to R-1 (Single Family Residential) for 24602 Fort Meigs Road.

Mr. Walters stated that this property is located on the east side of Fort Meigs Road, south of Perrysburg High School, and the City has recently acquired this from Middleton Township. The reason for this annexation was for water service for a newly constructed home. Reviewing the Land Use Plan, the appropriate use for this property would be Conservation Suburban, which does allow for the single family residence that was recently constructed there.

There being no further comments, the public hearing adjourned at 6:18 p.m.
