

MINUTES OF HEARING REGARDING
APPEAL OF HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION DECISION
PERRYSBURG CITY COUNCIL
OCTOBER 3, 2022

Jonathan Smith, President of Council, called the hearing to order at 5:30 p.m. Present were Council Members Kevin Fuller, Jan Materni, Tim McCarthy, Jonathan Smith, Barry VanHoozen, Cory Kuhlman, and Mark Weber (7). Also present was Kate Sandretto, Law Director.
