PRAC Minutes
February 1, 2010
REVISED VERSION (park assignments)**

The PRAC committee met at 7:00 pm, February 1, 2010 at the City Municipal Building. In attendance were Nick Camp, Ron Stewart, Joe Lawless, Mary Siefke, Tami Wise, Matt Skotynsky and Greg Kuhr.

2010 Park assignments, meeting dates and meeting locations were determined. See below.

There is a local group interested in having a dog park. They are looking at a number of different sites as a possibility.

Rotary Park – some of the work has begun. The drive and parking is now in. There were 2 grants that we were not awarded. The city will re-apply for these 2 grants this spring which are awarded sometime in the summer months.

The Perrysburg baseball organization has prepared plans and will be making a proposal to city council regarding fences around some of the diamonds at Rivercrest Park. This would allow for advertising and tournaments to be held at the park. The funds would be shared with the city and the baseball organization would also help with some of the maintenance services. They would also open the concession stands during soccer events. There will be public hearings in mid-March.

Perrysburg Youth Soccer Association (local recreation soccer league) raised the question to the Parks and Rec committee of allowing them exclusive use of the city soccer fields at Rivercrest Park and no longer pay fees to Perrysburg Soccer Club (local travel soccer league). The city told PYSA to work with PSC on resolving it and the city should not be involved.

Greg stated the city crews will begin cutting down some of the ash trees soon.

The next meeting will be at 7:00pm, March 29 at the new Public Services Building on Roachton Rd.
