

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

PERRYSBURG CITY COUNCIL

NOVEMBER 3, 2015

Mayor Olmstead called the first public hearing to order at 6:15 p.m. Present were Council Members John Kevern, Tim McCarthy, Rick Rettig and Barry VanHoozen (4). Todd Grayson and Jim Matuszak were absent (2). Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, David Creps, Finance Director, and Karlene Henderson, Law Director.

The purpose of the hearing was to consider the Special Approval Use for the proposed public restrooms on East Second Street across from the Perrysburg Messenger Journal building, immediately west of the dental office, at the site of the current portable restroom facilities. There were no questions or comments from City Council or from the public.

There being no further comments, the public hearing adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
