

HISTORIC LANDMARKS COMMISSION

JULY 8, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Don Earnhart. Commission members present were: Don Earnhart, Dennis Layman, Ruth Lucius, and Robert Seyfang (4). Absent: Pam Aubry, David Hoffmann, and John Walters (3). Also present was Planning and Zoning Administrator Brody Walters.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Mr. Layman moved to approve the minutes of the June 10, 2013 meeting as written. Ms. Lucius seconded and they were unanimously approved.

APPLICATION 10-13 – Robert Young requests a certificate of appropriateness for the addition of a “memorial walkway” within the Fort Meigs State Memorial Park. Consideration includes color, material and architectural style. The subject property is located at 29100 W. River Road and is zoned S-1 (Scenic and Open Space).

Mr. Young stated that he is a member of the Northern Light Lodge and they are celebrating the 200th anniversary of masonry in 2013. They would like to install a walkway to make the historical marker more accessible. Mr. Seyfang asked if it would be installed right away. Mr. Young said that they will be meeting the following day to discuss the Commission’s decision and will proceed from there. Mr. Young said the work will be supervised by a professional engineer. Mr. Earnhart asked if the pavers will be engraved. Mr. Young said they will not be engraved; one person has agreed to pay for the walkway. Ms. Lucius said this will look better than the pumpkin vine that is currently growing in the area.

Mr. Layman moved to approve Application 10-13 as submitted. Mr. Seyfang seconded, and it was unanimously approved.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:08 p.m.
