

HEALTH, SANITATION AND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMITTEE

MAY 26, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Todd Grayson. Committee members present were Todd Grayson, Tim McCarthy and Rick Rettig. Also present was Alice Godsey, Director of Public Utilities.

REQUEST LEGISLATION TO LEVY ASSESSMENTS FOR CSSD 210

Ms. Godsey reported that work on Cherry Street Sewer Separation District 210 is completed and the last step is approval of legislation to levy the assessments. The Committee agreed 3-0 to recommend approval of the legislation to levy assessments for CSSD 210.

SEWER BILL ADJUSTMENT

Ms. Godsey stated that the resident at 170 Birchdale Road had an upstairs pipe break at their home. They have requested an adjustment for the sewer portion of their bill since the water did not go into the sanitary sewer. The Committee agreed 3-0 to recommend approval of a sewer credit for Zafar Hussain, 170 Birchdale, in the amount of \$1,610.33.

UPDATE ON RADIO READ METER CONVERSIONS

Ms. Godsey stated that there are 23 residential customers who have not had their meters converted to a radio read. All 23 have received their quarterly bill with the additional charges on it. Four of those customers have objected to the installation of the radio read due to health concerns. Mr. Grayson asked Ms. Godsey to check and see if the 19 customers that we have not heard from have paid their bill or if it is delinquent. Ms. Godsey said that prior to the next meeting they will also do a dry run of the route to read the meters on these accounts to see how long it takes.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
