

HEALTH, SANITATION AND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMITTEE

MAY 12, 2015

The meeting was called to order at 5:03 p.m. by Chairman Todd Grayson. Committee members present were Todd Grayson and Rick Rettig. Tim McCarthy was absent. Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, Alice Godsey, Director of Public Utilities, and Doug Dariano, City Engineer.

CHANGE ORDER FOR CSSD 212

Ms. Godsey requested approval of a change order for Cherry Street Sewer Separation District 212 for additional paving on Walnut and W. Eighth Streets. The total amount of the work is \$100,530. Mr. Dariano explained that a portion of W. Eighth Street was trench patched in 2006 as part of District 204, but it does not make sense to do only half of the street. The contractor broke down the cost for that section separately and those funds, approximately \$28,000, will come from the resurfacing budget. Mr. Grayson stated that he has heard the argument several times that if we let everyone know ahead of time that the road needs to be resurfaced that they will run roughshod during construction and it will be more difficult for residents in the area. He questioned why we can't include the resurfacing in the bid and make it part of the contract that the road should be treated as if it will be patched and that one lane must remain open and make it a bid violation if they abuse it. Ms. Godsey said there will still be lateral cuts on both sides and this project was bid out that the roads would be patched and a significant part of Walnut will be trench patched. Mr. Grayson stated that if the section of Walnut Street that is being trench patched will have to be repaved within the next few years he would prefer just doing it now. Mr. Dariano said that Mr. Eckel would have that information in the Master Plan. Ms. Kabat said that based on the contractor's recommendation it is safe to say that it will exceed four years. Mr. Grayson asked that it be verified with Mr. Eckel and if it is due to be repaved within the next four years that we at least find out the cost. The Committee agreed 2-0 to recommend approval of the change order.

Ms. Kabat said that going forward it will make it easier now that we have the Street Master Plan and the Water Master Plan and we know the condition of the road.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:18 p.m.
