

## **SERVICE-SAFETY COMMITTEE**

The meeting was called to order at 6:17 p.m. by Chairman Jim Matuszak. Committee members present were: John Kevern, Jim Matuszak, and Barry VanHoozen. Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, and Jeff Klein, Fire Chief.

### **ADOPTING RATE SCHEDULE FOR HAZ-MAT INCIDENTS**

Chief Klein requested approval of a resolution adopting the Wood County Emergency Management Agency's rate schedule for recovering costs associated with hazardous material incidents. Mr. Matuszak asked if we would still be reimbursed if we did not adopt this rate schedule. Chief Klein stated that it is possible we would be reimbursed, but Wood County carries more clout and these amounts are streamlined throughout the county. Mr. Kevern asked if we have had any haz-mat incidents. Chief Klein said that the day of the fire at St. Rose there was an accident on the expressway involving hazardous materials, but because our Fire Division was involved with the fire, the Township Fire Division responded to the accident and they took care of billing. The Committee decided 3-0 to recommend approval of the resolution.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
