

## **SERVICE-SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING**

**SEPTEMBER 2, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 6:08 p.m. by Chairman Jim Matuszak. Committee members present were John Kevern, Jim Matuszak and Barry VanHoozen. Also present was Jon Eckel, Public Service Director.

### **AWARD BID FOR 2014 PAVEMENT MARKING PROGRAM**

Mr. Eckel reported that three bids were received for the 2014 Pavement Marking Program. The low bid was received from Zimmerman Paint Contractors for \$49,621.89 which is below the \$60,000 budgeted amount. Mr. Eckel said that the total expenditure usually exceeds the bid amount by \$4,000 to \$5,000 because although they try to get everything on the list before they bid it, they normally find more that needs to be done. Mr. Matuszak noted that the next lowest bid is still higher than Zimmerman's bid amount plus the extra amount anticipated.

The Committee agreed 3-0 to recommend approval of an ordinance authorizing an agreement with Zimmerman Paint Contractors for the 2014 Pavement Marking Program.

### **CITIZENS' CONCERNS**

Connie Sanford, 1202 Timberbrook Court, said that she spoke at the last City Council meeting regarding the Fire Division minimum staffing. She said it is still an issue; the minimum staffing level is still at four, and she feels it is inappropriate. She said if the minimum staffing level was reduced because of a budgetary issue, the Deputy Chief has retired and perhaps there is money in the budget that could be shifted. Mr. Matuszak explained that the Fire Division minimum staffing level is an administrative decision.

Phil Dombey, 110 W. Second Street, said, among other things, that before we spend the estimated 2.3 million dollars on the Mayor's proposed projects for uptown Perrysburg, we need to look at the study done years ago regarding the need for an additional fire station, fix the roads which are terrible, and come up with a second water source other than Lake Erie.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:18 p.m.
