

SERVICE COMMITTEE

JUINE 20, 2016

The meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m. by Chairperson Becky Williams. Committee members present were Barry VanHoozen and Becky Williams. Rick Rettig was absent. Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, Jon Eckel, Service Director and Doug Dariano, City Engineer.

CITIZENS' CONCERNS

Tom Steinecker, 1942 Hamilton Drive, was present to request that the Code be changed to allow driveways for single family residences to be 35' wide which is the width allowed for multi-family and commercial properties. He said that with three car garages the 35' width is needed. Ms. Kabat said that the Administration will discuss this internally with the affected divisions and will bring back a recommendation to the Committee.

FINAL RESOLUTION AND CONTRACT WITH ODOT FOR THE DIVERGENT DIAMOND

Ms. Kabat requested approval of an ordinance that contains the final resolution and contract with ODOT regarding the Divergent Diamond interchange at I475 and SR25. ODOT has provided their final cost estimate for the landscaping and irrigation sleeves and it shows the City's share to be \$16,700. Ms. Kabat added that there is \$60,000 in the budget. Ms. Williams said that her recollection was that the estimate was initially \$20,000 to \$25,000 so the final estimate is actually lower. The Committee agreed 2-0 to recommend approval of the ordinance.

FORT MEIGS ROAD PROJECT FINAL RESOLUTION AND CONTRACT WITH ODOT

Ms. Kabat stated that Mr. Dariano got the City out from the LPA status on the Fort Meigs Road widening project so once the utilities are moved ODOT will be running this project. The City is responsible for 20% of the cost which ODOT has estimated to be \$506,720. The City will issue a check to ODOT and if at the end of the project there are dollars that are not used, they will issue us a refund. Ms. Kabat requested approval of an ordinance that contains the final resolution and contract with ODOT for the Fort Meigs Road widening. Mr. VanHoozen asked what was budgeted for this project. Ms. Kabat said that since we were originally going to manage the project the total amount of the project was budgeted and then there was offsetting revenue from ODOT. Mr. Dariano said that the total amount was \$2.08 million dollars. The Committee agreed 2-0 to recommend approval of the ordinance.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 4:45 p.m.
