

Minutes of Perrysburg Service Committee

Meeting Held July 24, 2024

CALL TO ORDER - 5:30 PM

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by Chairperson Kerry Wellstein.

ROLL CALL

Committee members present were Kevin Fuller, Mark Weber, and Kerry Wellstein. Also present was Brian Thomas, City Engineer.

CITIZEN'S CONCERNS

None.

APPROVAL OF 6/26/24 MEETING MINUTES

There being no objections, the minutes of the June 26, 2024 meeting were approved 3-0.

AUCTION VEHICLE - 2006 GMC SIERRA

Mr. Thomas stated that the Department of Public Service would like to auction off a 2006 GMC Sierra that they no longer need. He said that it will not be replaced as the Building Maintenance employee's vehicle was shifted to replace this vehicle. The Committee agreed 3-0 to move this along to City Council.

BID RESULTS FOR ANNUAL ROAD SALT

Mr. Thomas reported that bids for road salt were opened on July 11th. He said that three bids were received, with the lowest bid coming from Compass Minerals America at a price of \$52.61 per ton. The bid was for 4,000 tons, but we only have to purchase what we need. He said the Department of Public Service can store 2,000 tons at their building, and we only used 900 tons at a cost of \$52,000 last year. Mr. Thomas said there is \$300,000 in the budget, and even if we needed all 4,000 tons, it would only be \$210,440. He added that this year's price is approximately \$5.26 less per ton than last year's price. The Committee agreed 3-0 to move this on to City Council.

OTHER BUSINESS

Ms. Wellstein asked about the status of the multi-use path near the Boat Club. Mr. Thomas said he does not have a date yet as they held off because of events at the Boat Club. He said that he will reach out to them as soon as he knows the date.

Ms. Wellstein said a neighbor reached out to her with concerns about the aesthetics of the fiber optic boxes on Front Street. She agreed that they are unsightly and detract from the historical look of the downtown. She questioned if they would be screened with plantings, and said it is something to think about.

Mr. Thomas informed the Committee that at next month's meeting, he will be requesting permission to apply for a grant to reconstruct Indiana Avenue from Findlay Street to the other side of the railroad tracks. He said that there is no multi-use path included in the construction. He said that once it is finished, if Council wishes, they can start having discussions about possibly rerouting US20 out of the downtown and run it through Indiana.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:37 p.m.
