

Minutes of Perrysburg Recreation Committee

Meeting Held September 10, 2024

CALL TO ORDER - 5:00 PM

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairperson Rick Rettig.

ROLL CALL

Committee members present were Rick Rettig, Barry VanHoozen, and Kerry Wellstein. Also present were Joe Fawcett, City Administrator, Tim Effler, Law Director, and Rob Ross, Service Director.

CITIZEN'S CONCERNS

APPROVAL OF 7/9/24 MEETING MINUTES

There being no objections, the minutes of the July 9, 2024 meeting were approved 3-0.

PURCHASE OF SUNSHADES FOR THE MUNICIPAL PARK BALLPARK BLEACHERS

Mr. Ross reported that there is \$75,000 in the budget for sunshades for the bleachers at Municipal Park. They received a quote from GameTime for \$68,047.80 for six sunshades. He said that they would be the same as the ones at Rivercrest Park. Mr. Rettig said that the ones at Rivercrest look fantastic. Mr. Ross said the plan is to purchase them this year and install them next year. Mr. VanHoozen asked if they plan to purchase any others, and Mr. Ross said not at this point. Mr. VanHoozen asked if they stay up all year, and Mr. Ross said that they do. The Committee agreed 3-0, but no legislation is required because the purchase was included in Resolution 52-2024 which was passed earlier this year.

2024 SUMMER REC PROGRAM UPDATE

Mr. Ross gave an end of year report on the Summer Recreation program. He said the program had 4,311 participants in 85 different activities. Total revenue was \$36,925 and total non-staff expenses were \$21,676. There was a brief discussion regarding attendance and some program changes for next year. Mr. Ross said that they received nothing but compliments about the program, and the Committee thanked Charles Brigode and Josh Roach for another successful year.

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Ross said that he looked into the cost of a sand volleyball court, and it would be approximately \$25,000 for two courts if they do the work in-house. He said that they will discuss it at their budget meeting. Mr. VanHoozen asked about the maintenance, and Mr. Ross said that Bowling Green said they drag or rake theirs once or twice a week.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 5:16 p.m.
