

## **Minutes of Perrysburg Recreation Committee**

### **2025 RECREATION BUDGET**

Mr. Ross presented the 2025 pool and recreation budgets to the Committee. He stated

that the \$12,000 increase in supplies for the pool is about \$2,000 for chemicals and \$10,000 for replacement of lounge chairs and umbrellas. The overall increase in the recreation budget is 2%.
